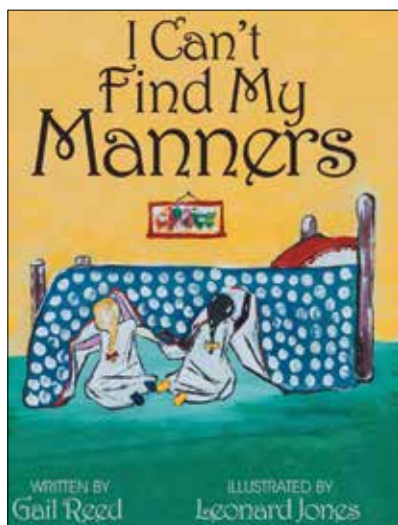

Kids will enjoy solving this forty-eight-piece puzzle. Afterwards, they can transform the puzzle container into a money bank. \$7

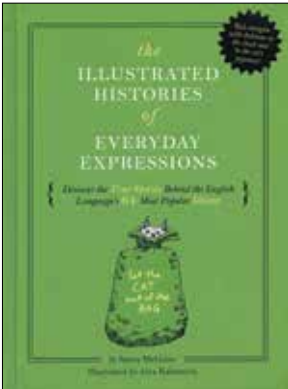

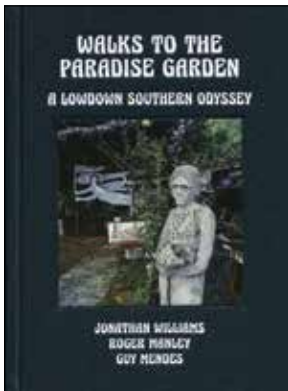
